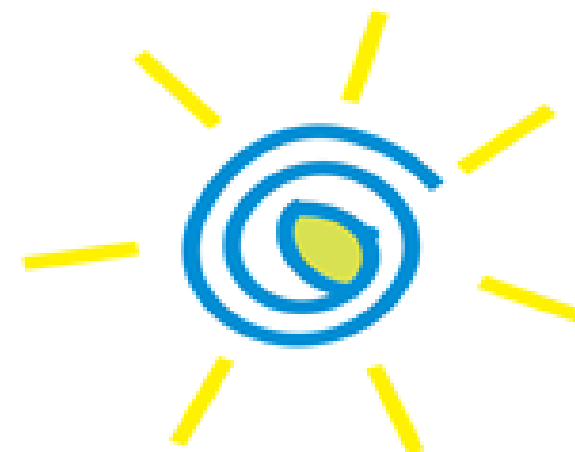

### BOOKLIST
